#### **Mothers and Fathers Know**

The Wild Chicory, the Queen Anne's Lace, and the Black Eyed Susans are all blooming now under blue skies and puffy white clouds, it is the middle of delicious summer in Rockford, Illinois. Yet all Mothers and Fathers are aware that all too soon days will become chilly and it will be time for children to return to school. Will we all be ready?

The Mothers and Fathers of the children in Haiti are also aware of the needs of their children as they prepare for returning to school. We remember that there is no free public education in Haiti and each child must pay \$250 for the school year tuition, uniforms, books, back packs and a daily meal. If the family cannot pay, the child cannot attend school. Many families in Haiti do not have the money to send their children to school.

Our Second First Church led by James and Odette Casimir, has a partnership with the Town of Saut-d'Eau, Haiti in assisting 54 children with the cost of their \$250 per child tuition for the school year. Last year four of our sponsored children graduated from school which made room for 4 new students to begin their studies. Congratulation students!

Our church Mission Team has offered to donate \$1,250 towards the total cost of \$13,500. tuition for our 54 students.

If you would like to contribute to this project, you may make a donation to SecondFirst Church with *Haiti Education Fund* in the memo line. This project sends a message of peace, justice and joy to children who live far away but are in our thoughts and deeds.
